Roads

Chris Bilau – Board Member reviewed the Asphalt Roads Assessment and Financial Plan presented at the 2016 Annual HOA Meeting for new members in attendance. An update on the current state of the roads was presented along with the maintenance plans for 2018. The floor was opened for questions and discussion. Several members offered various options for short-term and long-term maintenance and replacement, Teresa Beebe proposed a focus group be formed to take on the task of researching the options presented, financial impact to members and report back to community. Members were asked to sign up for the focus group. Thank you to those who volunteered.

Field Maintenance and Snow Removal

Chris Bilau - Board Member provided an update on fertilizing and mowing.

Fertilizing/Spraying that was initially scheduled in October was delayed due to winds and should occur the week of November 13th. Should it be delayed for any reason, it will be moved to Spring of 2018.

Mowing of common areas: Entrances and trail. Presently this has been managed by Bill Kilmer with assistance from Kyle Newsome. The Board is asking for volunteers to take turns to help with the maintenance of these areas. A quote was presented from a company at \$100/each mowing for entrances and \$80/each mowing of trail. A few members volunteered to help versus hiring it done. Volunteers are to email Teresa Beebe (tabeebe16@gmail.com) if interested in helping. An email will be sent in March as a reminder.

Snow removal – President, Mike Beister stated that Smither's has been contracted for snow removal again. Snow removal will occur as follows: Overnight snow – snow will be removed by 6:00 a.m., should snow continue, a clean-up removal will occur later that same day. Ice – salt is not used unless conditions are severe, which occurred this last winter.
